Column 1: Reference Number. Please use the reference numbers in table 8 in the 2004 Report to identify each of your reform nominations.

Column 2: Rule/Guidance. As a crosscheck of column 1, we ask that the agency include the short title of the rule or guidance from table 8 in the 2004 Report.

Column 3: Priority Status. We ask that agencies develop a consistent method for assigning priority status to your reforms. An agency should identify their high priority reforms with a 1, their medium priority reforms with a 2, and the reforms they would not like to pursue at this time with a 3. We encourage agencies to avoid assigning an "undecided" status to particular reform nominations.

Column 4: Priority Status Justification. For each reform, we ask that you supply a concise, adequate rationale for your proposed priority status.

Column 5: Timeline and Milestones. For each reform that an agency proposes to pursue (i.e. priority status 1 and 2), please supply: a timeline for the rulemaking or guidance development stages, and indicators of progress toward your goals. In the rare event that an agency cannot decide on the status of a reform nomination, please provide a timeline for when the agency will make a final decision regarding the regulatory reform.
