4	Coastal Zone Management Act Federal Consistency Regulations	[REDACTED]	<p>NOAA published a proposed rule to revise the Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA) federal consistency regulations on June 11, 2003. The comments provided to OMB by the National Association of Manufacturers (NAM) on NOAA's proposed rule are the same as some comments submitted to NOAA on NOAA's proposed rule. NOAA has yet to issue a final rule, thus, there is a limitation on NOAA's current ability to respond to NAM's comments. The measures contained in NOAA's proposed rule contain a strong package of improvements to the CZMA regulations that would continue to balance state-federal-industry interests embodied in the CZMA, while providing for more efficient approval of energy and other projects by providing greater clarity, transparency and predictability in the regulatory process.</p> <p>[REDACTED] NOAA's proposed changes would, however, significantly reduce the time period for the processing of CZMA appeals by the Secretary of Commerce [REDACTED]</p> <p>[REDACTED] NOAA will consider carefully the public comment received in issuing any final rule.</p>	[REDACTED]
